DAY OF EXAM:

- Arrive on time
- Bring two forms of identification, including one with a current photograph. Bring one of the following:
 - Driver's license with photograph
 - State ID card with photograph
 - Passport
 - Military ID card with photograph

The second form of ID must display your name and a signature (e.g. credit card with signature, social security card with signature, employment or student ID with signature).

You will receive your pass/fail status at the testing site

- Certificates will be mailed to those who pass within 4–6 weeks of the examination date

- Complete CNRN Recertification every 5 years.
 - Option 1: Retake the exam
 - Option 2: 75 CE hours working in neuroscience full-time
 - Option 3: 100 CE hours working in neuroscience part-time
