- Earn RN licensure.
- Have 1 year (2,080 hours) of neuroscience nursing experience (indirect or direct) in the last 3 years.
- Complete an application for the CNRN exam at <http://abnncertification.org/certification-center>.

DAY OF EXAM AT A TESTING CENTER

- Arrive on time.
- Bring one form of identification that contains a current photograph, your current name, and your signature. Bring one of the following:
 - Driver's license with photograph
 - State identification card with photograph
 - Passport
 - Military identification card with photograph

No forms of temporary identification will be accepted.

You will receive your pass/fail status at the testing site.

- Certificates will be mailed within 4–6 weeks of the examination date to those who pass.

PREPARE TO TAKE THE EXAM WITH LIVE REMOTE PROCTORING (LRP)

Review the technical requirements and exam day instructions at ABNNcertification.org/LRP.

You will receive your score immediately upon completion of your LRP exam. A pass or fail screen will be displayed upon completion of the exam. Additionally, a more detailed score report will be emailed to you.
