- Have 1 year (2,080 hours) of stroke nursing experience in the last 3 years (indirect or direct)

PREPARE FOR THE EXAM:

The exam is 170 questions and 3 hours in length. 20 of the 170 items are pre-test items that are not scored.

DAY OF EXAM:

- Arrive on time
- Bring two forms of identification, including one with a current photograph. Bring one of the following:
 - Driver's license with photograph
 - State ID card with photograph
 - Passport
 - Military ID card with photograph

The second form of ID must display your name and a signature (e.g., credit card with signature, social security card with signature, employment or student ID with signature).

You will receive your pass/fail status at the testing site

- Certificates will be mailed to those who pass within 4–6 weeks of the examination date

- Complete SCRN Recertification every 5 years.
 - **Option 1:** Retake the exam
 - **Option 2:** 50 CE hours working in stroke full-time
